## Photography – At Events

Policy and Procedures for the use of photographic, video and image recording equipment including mobile phones:

All members or visitors to Anchor Bowmen's shoots, who wish to take photographs or use any other image recording equipment, including mobile phones are required to comply with the following:

Seek prior permission from the Field Captain, who will:

- Record details of the photographer on the appropriate form
- Issue the photographer with an ID Badge

The photographer will wear the badge at all times and return it as they leave the shoot.

The photographer must obtain permission from the person of whom the picture is to be taken of. In the case of junior archers, parental consent must always be sought prior to any photographs being taken.

Juniors should not be left alone with the photographer.

If any person complains or expresses concern the photographer must respect the rights of other people and stop taking photographs immediately.

To comply with Anchor Bowmen's Safeguarding Policy and Procedures we request that any person wishing to take any kind of photography completes the following form before carrying out any such activity. We reserve the right to refuse permission if any person is unable to meet or abide by these conditions.
