

Anchor Bowmen Archery Club

252 Achievement Badge Scheme

We are pleased to introduce the new Anchor Bowmen Archery Club 252 Award Scheme, which is effective from March 2014.

The scheme has been devised to encourage all members to become proficient at a number of different distances and to recognise the progress made by individuals as they improve their standard of shooting.

Rules

- Scheme is open to all ABAC full members (seniors and juniors)
- Six sighters to be followed immediately by three dozen scored arrows, to be shot at a distance of the archer's choosing which can be shot as part of any qualifying round, with a score of 252 or greater to be achieved to qualify for the award
- The three dozen arrows may be shot alone or as the first three dozen of a longer Imperial round
- In the interests of consistency, a score of 252 (or greater) needs to be achieved twice to qualify for the 252 award
- The score must be witnessed by a second senior (over 18) member of ABAC
- A distance award may be claimed multiple times if different bow styles are used (recurve, compound, longbow etc)
- GNAS Shooting Rules will apply

The awards are as follows:
